Garriott Rd. church of Christ Trip & Activity Rules

- 1.) Everyone is welcome to bring guests on day trips, but not overnight trips (unless it is otherwise specified by the youth minister). You are responsible for getting your guest to fill out a medical release form prior to leaving. Guests are required to follow the rules. Give guests a copy of this sheet.
- 2.) Obey all sponsors at all times
- 3.) Never leave the group without permission from the youth minister. When leaving the group, go in pairs. Never go alone.
- 4.) When going to religious functions (youth rallies, etc.), you should wear clothing appropriate for church services on Sunday evenings or Wednesdays. <u>No</u> shorts.
- 5.) Shorts are allowed on recreational trips with these exceptions:

No spandex shorts or tight fitting shorts or pants of any kind; No short shorts (anything shorter than right above the knee);

no short shorts (anything shorter than right above the kne

6.) The following clothing should <u>never</u> be worn:

Halter tops, tube tops, or any shirt or blouse that exposes the stomach or shows cleavage;

Shirts with spaghetti straps;

Tank Tops or muscle shirts;

T - Shirts with vulgar words or meanings;

T- Shirts with rude or objectionable slogans.

Please remember that if you chose to wear these things, you will be asked to change into something more appropriate or to not participate in the activity.

- 7.) The vans should be kept clean. Do not leave trash in the vans.
- 8.) Make all guests feel welcome and part of the group.
- 9.) Do not harass other people in the group. Treat people the way you would want to be treated.
- 10.) No rude, crude, or profane language is to be use at any time.
- 11.) Conduct yourself appropriately with members of the opposite sex. (See next page)

- 12.) No boys in girls rooms or girls in boys rooms without a sponsor.
- 13.) Ultimately, you should act in a way that other people will be able to tell that Christ lives in you.
- 14.) As for any other matters not described in this, the minister or sponsors will decide what is appropriate.
- 15.) When we go on trips or have activities as a youth group that are for spiritual development and fellowship, this means that no electronic devices will be allowed (cell phones, i-pods, etc.). Lacy and myself will have our phones available for anyone who needs to contact their parents.

Couples:

If you bring your boyfriend or girlfriend, you have a unique opportunity to be an example to the rest of the group in how they should act with their boyfriends/girlfriends.

Sitting together is permissible but anything else is not.

No PDA (Public Displays of Affection).

DO NOT leave the group and go somewhere by yourselves.

You will still be expected to participate in group activities, so please don't just sit in a corner and focus on each other.

Discipline Policy:

As young men and women striving to be like Christ we have the highest expectations for your behavior. In the event that these rules are disregarded or disrespected my first course of action will be to speak to you on an individual basis. If this is not sufficient to correct the behavior, you and I will go together to visit with your parents. If a behavioral problem remains, your participation will be limited for the spiritual well being of the rest of the group.
