The apostle Paul wrote the Colossae brethren (which likewise applies to each follower of Christ today):

If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God. When Christ, who is our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory (Col. 3:1-4).

God's children, Christians, will focus on "things above" - notice the imperative to seek and set.

What Will I Do When My Affections Are Above? Obviously I will think about heavenly things. I will study and grow in knowledge about eternal matters. I will read books, periodicals, and related works that will further develop me spiritually. I will attend worship services and take other opportunities to learn more about Christ and my service to Him. I will hunger and pursue any avenue that will bring me closer to my Lord.
