Noah got his family on the ark. Joshua was determined that his family would "serve the Lord." Eunice gave her son Timothy the gift of faith. It's our turn.

We can, we must, and with God's help, we will save our children. Make saving yourself and then your children, your highest priority. Be an example to your children that's worth imitating. Have a faith that is contagious to all in your house.

Be the all that separates your children from the devil who stalks them. Pray with your family. Talk to God about your children and talk to your children about God. Worship with your children. Do this "every time the church doors are open" and one day you'll be in heaven with your children and your children's children.
