BE TRANSFORMED

The one constant is CHANGE. Everything is changing. The world is changing. You are changing—just look in the mirror. Outward change is inevitable but are you changing on the inside? Paul says, "Don't be conformed to this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind."

Change is possible. The Christian is to undergo a metamorphosis. Think about how a tadpole turns into a frog. A caterpillar becomes a butterfly. You are to become like Jesus (2 Cor. 3:18).
