BE TRANSFORMED

The one constant is CHANGE. Everything is changing. The world is changing. You are changing—just look in the mirror. Outward change is inevitable but are you changing on the inside? Paul says, “Don’t be conformed to this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind.”

Change is possible. The Christian is to undergo a metamorphosis. Think about how a tadpole turns into a frog. A caterpillar becomes a butterfly. You are to become like Jesus (2 Cor. 3:18).

Change is personal (Rom. 12:1-2). Look at all of the personal pronouns. “You” and “Your.” God is talking to you. The Bible is full of people who turned themselves over to God. The whole reason that we offer an invitation, we invite people to change.

Change is practical. That we may prove what is that good, acceptable, and perfect will of God (Rom. 12:2). One of the most frequent questions asked is, “How can I know God’s will?” If we present ourselves to God and let Him change us, this will be the result: You will know the will of God.

The non-emergency number of the Enid PD is 580-242-7000.

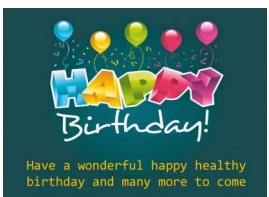
