Look Unto Jesus

I hope you enjoyed having the Freed-Hardeman University Chorale here last week as much as I did. What a talented and uplifting group of young people they truly are. During their performance, I noticed something that was vital for their success. As they were singing their sweet melodies in perfect time and tune, each of them individually had their eyes fixed upon the director, Gary McKnight. They adjusted their volume and emphasis based upon the way he conducted them. Even though they had probably practiced their songs dozens and dozens of times, they still looked to him and trusted him for correctness, continuity, and harmony.

An important gospel parallel came to mind as I witnessed this. Even though we may feel we know how to "perform" before the Savior, we still need to look to Him and His word for proper guidance. It is only then that we can reach the correctness, continuity, and harmony that He desires for us individually and as a church.

What do you suppose would have happened if each of the Chorale members would have stopped following Mr. McKnight's direction and went with what they felt was right, regardless of the way the music was written or the way he desired it to be sung? I know what would have happened—we would have cringed rather than complimented. It would have been a disaster.

Just as a choral group or an orchestra needs a conductor, so do we as the body of Christ. When we turn the whole focus of our attention to our Lord and acknowledge that He is in command, our lives will give forth harmonious music that is pleasing to Him. Too many people (and churches) focus on the world and let worldly influences lead them. Doing so is a recipe for disharmony and disaster. Let us be reminded of the need to follow Christ and His will only, setting our sights on heaven.

"If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth" (Col. 3:1-2).
