Why Believe In God?

- 1. Because it's foolish not to believe in God. The Psalmist says. "The fool has said in his heart there is no **God"** (Psa. 14:1). There are good reasons to believe in God. First, the heavens declare the glory of God (Psa. 19:1). How do I know that God exists? The creation. Things don't make themselves. Every house has a builder. The creation says there is a creator. Second, design in the universe is indicative of intelligence. A painting suggests a painter. Look at the design of the human body. When you examine the body, you know that is not a freak of nature. Third, mortality isn't human or sub-human, it's supra-human. It comes from God. If morality is human, then whatever you want to do is moral. Who am I to say that your actions are not moral? If it's human, we get to decide what our morality is. No one wants to live with the consequences of that. By that standard, what Hitler did would be moral. After all, we get to decide. But man does not get to decide what is moral. That's God's prerogative. Fourth, there is so much evidence for God's existence that come Judgment Day, we will be without excuse (Rom. 1:20).
- 2. Because not believing in God leads to a degenerate lifestyle (Psa. 14:1b-3). What you believe determines how you live. In Romans 1:18-32, Paul illustrated how lack of faith in God leads to a corrupt lifestyle. The knowledge of God restrains evil. Could you imagine what life would be like if no one believed in God? You wouldn't want to leave your house.
- 3. Because one day you will meet God (2 Cor. 5:10). One day we will all stand before God and give an account of our lives to God. I imagine it might be a terrible shock to pass from this life to the next and know that you had been a fool. In Revelation 20, we have a judgment scene where all humans stand before God to be judged. Everyone whose names are not in the Book of Life will be cast into the Lake of Fire.

Don't be a fool.
