It Is Hard To Unlove the World

The peak of hurricane season is approaching, and you can be sure that if a major one threatens America's coast, almost every television network will send someone to stand in the storm in front of a camera to report the wind and the rain. Why? To attract attention, perhaps, but mostly because it communicates perceived, instant credibility. The viewer is supposed to attach a measure of integrity to the news from a media network about the event if the viewer can see the reporter's poncho flapping in the wind while he talks into the microphone.

A messenger wants instant credibility from his audience. The Bible writers communicated with credibility. But they did not use stunts or antics; their words were confirmed by the Holy Spirit (Heb. 2:14). When we read Scripture, we can believe it. Including the following:

“Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world. And the world is passing away, and the lust of it: but he who does the will of God abides forever” (1 John 2:15-17).

YOU CANNOT LOVE BOTH. If anyone loves the world, the love of the father is not in him. This rule is repeated by Jesus (Matt. 6:24) and James (James 4:4) and is even found in the Old Testament (Joshua 24:15). A car only has one steering wheel. God and the world cannot drive a man. There is only room for one.

IT IS HARD TO UNLOVE THE WORLD. For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes and the pride of life... Once we learn the world's habits, it's easy to stop today but hard not to start again tomorrow. We condition our bodies for sin so that it is hard to uncondition them. We can discover appetites that belong to the world and that God has no business with.

GOD MADE IT EASY FOR US TO LOVE HIM. He who does the will of God abides forever. Every good thing we have, we have because God gave it. God gave us His son so that we could abide forever. What has the world done for us lately? Love God, not the world. It will be worth it. You can be sure!
