THE SIMPLICITY OF THE GOSPEL

Man is sinful. God is holy and righteous. We need a Savior because we cannot save ourselves. So, God sent a Savior in the person of Jesus Christ. Jesus suffered numerous beatings, followed by a painful scouring. Jesus was led away to be crucified. Jesus hung on that cross for six hours. He uttered seven statements, the most significant was, “It is finished.” What was finished? Satan was finished. Sin was finished. Jesus on the cross took all of our sin upon Himself and paid the penalty for humanity’s sin. What a Savior! What a God!

However, the fact that Jesus died and rose again, is of no benefit to us unless we respond to the gospel, the good news that Jesus died for our sins and rose again. So, what is man’s response? In Romans 1:16-17, Paul said that we are made right with God through faith. But, James tells us that faith without works is dead (Jas. 2:26). James is not saying that we’re saved by faith plus works. There is no good work that we can do to save ourselves (Tit. 3:5). What James is talking about is a faith that works. You see, real faith can be seen by ACTION. Real faith responds to God’s will. It is active and can be seen by faithfulness to God’s word. Faith is seen in repentance, confession and baptism.

Have you responded to the gospel? Jesus says that you die in your sins if you don’t believe Jesus is the Savior who came in the flesh (John 8:24).

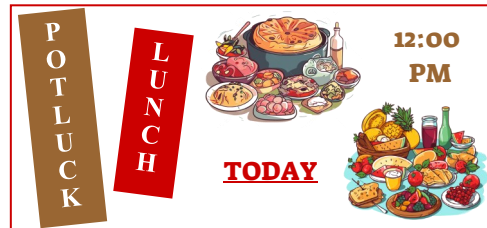
