THE VALUE OF SILENCE

The Native Americans tell a fable. “Once, a bear and a fox, who were each hunting for food, encountered each other on the trail. The bear said: ‘You will not get any of my game,’ and began to growl and roar at the fox. But the fox said nothing and slipped away. Soon the fox had his supper, but the bear was still roaring. The fox thought to himself, ‘If I had been growling and roaring, I would have never heard this rabbit or be eating my meal.’ The moral of the story is that silence is the best companion of the hunter.

The fact is, there is a great value in silence. While there are times to speak out, there are also times when silence is important — even a blessing. For instance, Teresa of India said: “We need to find God, and He cannot be found in noise and restlessness. God is the friend of silence. See how nature — trees, flowers, grass — grows in silence; see the stars, the moon and the sun, how they move in silence. We need silence to be able to touch souls.” No wonder the Bible says: “Therefore the prudent man keeps quiet in such times, for the times are evil” (Amos 5:13).

Make time to spend a few moments in silence and use that time to study about God and talk with Him, and you will find great blessings.
