ANOTHER REASON “ONCE SAVED, ALWAYS SAVED” DOCTRINE ISN’T TRUE

(Hebrews 10:26-31) *“For if we sin willfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, but a certain fearful expectation of judgment, and fiery indignation which will devour the adversaries. Anyone who has rejected Moses’ law dies without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses. Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace? For we know Him who said, ‘Vengeance is Mine, I will repay,’ says the Lord, And again, ‘The LORD will judge His people.’ It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.”*

To “sanctify” means to set apart from the world and consecrate to God. In the New Testament, a person who has been sanctified has been saved or is one of God’s who has been set apart from the world. I want that clear as we look at the Hebrew writer’s words. A person who has become a Christian, saved, sanctified, can no longer sin willfully and still be covered by the sacrifice of Christ. That’s what the writer said. He says that to do so, by a Christian or sanctified person, is to make the Lord’s sacrifice worthless, vain, or trampled underfoot. He finishes this thought with the consequences of doing so. “Vengeance is Mine, I will repay,” says the Lord. “The Lord will judge His people.” Some will protest and say that judging isn’t the same as condemning. In this case it is or why the next sentence, “It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God”?

When we vow to take a spouse for life, we had better honor it. When we vow to change our way of living and live for God, we better honor it for life. Peter warns Christians about returning to our sinful ways. 2 Peter 2:20-22 tells us that a Christian would have been better off never becoming one than the state he will be in if he returns to his former sinful life as a dog to his own vomit or a sow to its mud hole.

“Once saved, always saved” is a false doctrine. Why not say, “Once saved, stay saved”? We can’t go back to our old life and live in eternity with Jesus.
