THE BEGINNING OF SIN

Most of us, when we think about the first sin, think of the account near the beginning of the Bible in Genesis 3 when Adam and Eve ate of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. However, near the end of the Bible there are some statements regarding how sin began in regard to angels that actually refer to a time before the events in the garden of Eden.

Second Peter 2 is a chapter that warns about the dangers of following false teachers. Just as there were false teachers in Old Testament times who enticed people to sin, there will be false teachers among us who live in the Christian dispensation who will entice us to sin. For that reason this chapter warns of how God did not spare those who sinned from punishment and neither will He spare us from punishment if we follow in their sinful footsteps. Verses 4 through 8 of this chapter give a brief chronological list of some examples of those who sinned.

The first example is the angels, found in verse 4, warning that, "...God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment." Here we learn that some of the angels God created sinned. The nature of the sin is not revealed, but the consequences are that they have been delivered into chains of darkness to be reserved unto judgment. We know from Hebrews 2:16 that no sin offering was made for angels; Jesus did not appear to take the form of an angel to give them a way of salvation from sin, instead He took the form of a man to give mankind salvation. Thus, when the end comes, those angels who chose to sin will suffer punishment. Jesus warned in Matthew 25:41 that hell is a place of everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels.

Verse 6 of the book of Jude reveals a little more about the nature of the angels' sins, "And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains unto darkness unto the judgment of the great day." God gave these angels a place, but being dissatisfied with their domain, they rebelled. They did not keep their first estate, but left their God-intended habitation. They wanted to change the role God gave to them. Likely this involved pride in their hearts. First Timothy 3:6, in refusing a novice to be appointed as an elder, explains, "lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the devil." Though the meaning of "condemnation of the devil" may simply be parallel to "the snare of the devil," found in the following verse (1 Timothy 3:7), it is likely that 1 Timothy 3:6 is describing how the devil fell into condemnation through being lifted up with pride in his heart. A new Christian who is appointed to such a prominent position in the church could become filled with pride to the point that he chooses not to heed God's instructions, and, like the devil, throw off the limitations God has set.

When Satan tempted Eve in Eden, he convinced her that sin would make her and Adam like gods, knowing good from evil (Genesis 3:5-6). People today are no different. Instead of following the commands God has given for our benefit, people usually want to do something else and be somewhere else. When we do deviate from God's commands, we follow in the footsteps of the first couple (Romans 5:12).

Though we have all sinned, we do not have to meet the final end that the devil and his angels will certainly meet. We can avail ourselves of the grace of God extended through Christ's death on the cross. We can then choose to submit to God's authority so that we can enjoy eternal bliss with Him in heaven.
