## REASONS TO RESIST TEMPTATION

Someone has wisely said, "Opportunity only knocks once, but temptation leans on the doorbell." The Bible makes clear that (1) All are tempted (Jas. 1:13), (2) Temptation never comes from God (Jas. 1:13), (3) Temptation is not sin (Heb. 4:15), (4) Temptation can be resisted (Jas. 4:14). Now let's look at some reasons why we must resist temptation.

- Failure to resist temptation will eventually rob you of your confidence in the power of God to give people victory over sin.** Consequently, you will be hesitant to offer Christ as the answer to others who are controlled by sin. Listen, a controlling habit will rob you of your desire to share your faith with others. Why? Because you will feel like a hypocrite! Hypocrites are unable to convince others that Jesus is the answer to their sin problems. If Jesus hasn't been the answer for you, how can you enthusiastically recommend Him to others? One of the immediate results of being set free from a controlling habit is the desire to share with others the power of God that has been experienced in your life.
- Choosing not to deal with sin leads to what Scripture calls a hard heart (Heb. 3:13).** A hard heart is an impenetrable heart, a heart resistant to the promptings of the Holy Spirit and encouragement that comes from the brethren. It is a closed mind when it comes to doing right. Developing a hard heart is a process that takes time. Each time a Christian recognizes sin in their life, feels convicted and yet does nothing about it, they become less and less sensitive to the promptings of the Holy Spirit. We see this when folks forsake the assembly. At first there is deep conviction, then over time, there is no conviction. This happens with all sin. The Bible warns if this process is allowed to continue, God will eventually turn people over to their sin (Rom. 1:18-24). For some there is no return (Heb. 6:4-6). Be careful!
- Sin always results in death (Jas. 1:14-15).** Death is separation from God (Isa. 59:2). I'm talking about spiritual and eternal death (Rev. 20:11-15).
