DID YOU HUG AN ATHEIST?

On Friday, June 7, 2013, unbelievers across the nation celebrated the fifth annual "Hug an Atheist" Day. The purpose behind this celebration is "to tell the world that we are humans like them and the only difference is that we believe in science and not a supernatural being." (But notice here the false dilemma between science and the supernatural—there are many highly qualified and respected scientists today who believe in God.)

Atheism in America is a curious thing. Polls indicate that atheists are virtually the least trusted group in American society. Because of this attitude, unbelievers have taken it upon themselves to generate solidarity. There are self-help books, survival guides, and other helps aimed at giving atheist support in their choice of disbelief in God.

If atheists are among the least trusted individuals in our society, do we treat them differently than other non-Christians? We have to look closely at ourselves and make sure that we, like God, are no "respector of persons" (Acts 10:34, also Romans 2:11). What did the apostle Peter mean when he said this? First of all, God does not play favorites. Unlike human beings, God does not automatically favor some over others for arbitrary reasons or personal preferences. But He also refuses to show partiality when it comes to sin. He does not excuse some sins while treating "pet peeves" more harshly. All sin is worthy of death (Romans 6:23).

The Bible makes God's desires clear: He wants all to come to repentance (1 Timothy 2:4; 2 Peter 3:9). The same should go for us. We all have a tendency to view some sins as more heinous than others, even though all of them are worthy of death. But each person is a unique creation made in God's image, who should receive the blessing of Christ's command to "Love your neighbor as yourself."
