TRUTHS TO THINK ABOUT

TRUTH #1: Hell is real, and it is a place of eternal punishment.

Some think hell is over blown. Others, it's just a fairy tale conjured up to get people to become Christians. The Bible teaches that hell is a place of punishment created for the devil and his angels (Matt. 25:41). We don't like to talk about hell these days. You never hear a televangelist preach on hell. Jesus believed in hell. Jesus said hell is a place where the worm never dies and the fire is not quenched. Hell is a place of darkness. A place of torment. The Bible teaches that hell is a real place. Hell is a place of intense pain (Lu. 16). A place of weeping. If the Bible mentioned hell only one time, I would be obligated to preach it. But, the Bible mentions hell 14 times. If there is no hell, then Calvary was a mistake. If no pending punishment, no purpose for pardon. Jesus talked about hell more than anyone else. You know why? He didn't want anyone to have to go there. Hell is one's personal choice. Reject Christ and you reserve your place in hell. Obey the gospel and reserve your place in heaven.

TRUTH #2: Heaven is an awesome place of eternal reward.

Heaven is a literal place. Heaven means all will be made new. The older we get, the more we look forward to heaven. Amen! No kidney stones. No root canals. No diseases. No sickness. No death! We allow Satan to dupe us into thinking that earthly pleasures are somehow in the same league as the heavenly ones. WRONG! Heaven will put earth to shame in every category. Heaven is an exclusive place. Heaven will not be boring. Jesus is there and has been planning for your arrival. Everything that is perfect here will be better there. Everything that is bad here will be absent there.

TRUTH #3: Jesus is returning soon (1 Thess. 4:16-17).

We wish we knew when, but God decided we did not need to know. It's not for you to know the times and epochs which the Father has fixed by His own authority. Many theories abound but one thing is certain — Jesus is coming soon. You had better be ready! You need to tell others to get ready. In light of what I just shared with you about heaven and hell, how can you not say something? How apathetic must a Christian be to believe in heaven and hell and remain quiet? I don't want God to say to me on Judgment Day: "I moved this family right next to you." "I brought this person by your path every day and you never once mentioned My son to them." We need to get on our knees and beg God to give us boldness to go out and proclaim the good news. If we know people are headed toward a Christless eternity, then we must do all that we can to divert their journey from hell to heaven. Charles Spurgeon said, "If sinners be condemned, at least let them leap to hell over our bodies. If they perish, let them perish with our arms about their knees. Let no one go there unwarned and unprayed for."
