A MORNING CLOUD

In the days of Hosea, God took Israel to court. "Hear the word of the Lord, you people of Israel, for the Lord brings a charge against the inhabitants of the land" (Hosea 4:1). God's charge against Israel was as modern as tomorrow's newscast. "There is no truth or mercy or knowledge of God in the land." Does that sound like the IRS scandal to you? Who will ever know the truth in that matter? And why was no mercy shown to those of opposing views? Surely it is because there is no knowledge of God in the land.

Ask those involved in the sin and they will say, "I am righteous in the matter!" (Or perhaps they will take the 5th). But even there we are like ancient Israel who claimed innocence before God while worshiping idols (Hosea 4:17-18). God has a charge against that attitude also: "...For your faithfulness is like a morning cloud, and like the early dew it goes away" (Hosea 6:4).

How is your faithfulness to God? Is it like the morning cloud that soon blows away? Is it like the dew that appears every morning and is gone with the sunrise? Is it "Sunday morning only"? When you stand before God's judgment court, what charge will He bring against you? "Be faithful until death," He said.
