ANOTHER PROBLEM AT CORINTH

Putting ourselves in Paul's place as he dealt with this truly troubled church may make us wonder why he even bothered. First Corinthians reveals that they were applying worldly standards to just about everything in religion. They divided over favorite preachers (chs. 1-4), they boasted about a brother's wickedness (ch. 5), they sued each other in civil court (ch. 6), etc., etc.

Thankfully, his first letter seemed to have taken effect. By the writing of Second Corinthians, we read that they had been moved to "godly sorrow" that led to genuine "repentance" (2 Corinthians 7:9, 10). We ought to rejoice and be encouraged by the fact that a church so far off course could be brought back to the way of truth so quickly by a single letter of rebuke and correction.

However, there was a new problem suggested by one of Paul's closing comments. As he reminded them of his association with them, he lamented, "And I will very gladly spend and be spent for you; though the more abundantly I love you, the less I be loved" (2 Corinthians 12:15). Brothers, sisters and friends, that just is not right. On the other hand, it is sometimes reality.

We must accept that we cannot make others love us. Yet, we must continue to "love, bless, do good to, and pray" for those who do not love us (Matthew 5:44).

We must believe that, in spite of exceptions to God's rule, being loving works His wonders. "Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good" (Romans 12:21).

P.S. This preacher knows he is loved.
