Why am I here? What am I supposed to do now? Where do I start? These are some of the questions I have asked myself since I was cuffed that day on February 11, 2023!

I know the hounds of heaven have been nipping at my heels for years now and like Jonah, when called by GOD, I ran in the other direction as fast as I could. Jonah ran because of self-righteousness. My shortcomings, and the demons I have obeyed for all those years, while I was running from a loving FATHER who was saddened by the bad choices I was making, because HE knew the best thing for me was HIM. As I hold the mirror of HIS word up, I still find things in me that are not from my FATHER and instead of running from the FATHER, I run to the FATHER so HE can prune the things off that are not like CHRIST so that I may be more like HIS SON.

What am I supposed to do now? Be conformed to JESUS as HE strips away the world that has grabbed onto me with a death grip. So, where do I start? GOD is all about relationships, I am to be conformed to the likeness of JESUS, and JESUS said if you love ME, you will keep MY commandments. When JESUS was asked, “what is the greatest commandment,” HE points to Deut. 6:4-5 to love the LORD your GOD with all your heart, soul, and strength and the second is like it to love your neighbor as yourself. 1 John 4:7-8 says that GOD is love. 1 Cor. 13:13 says that of hope faith and love that love is the greatest.
