## Discernment

One of the greatest blessings that God gives us is the ability to “winnow the chaff from the wheat.” Under His instruction, we have the ability – nay, obligation – to separate fabrication from Truth.

Every day, we’re inundated with false teachings. The media pursues its own worldly agenda. Social media overflows with falsehoods and distortion. The Internet itself is rife with misinformation, worsened by AI-generated “information pollution.”

Sadly, many, if not most, refuse to seek genuine understanding of any truth. So-called facts are accepted – and vehemently defended – at face value. Society marginalizes critical thinking. Instead, people prefer quick, emotionally-charged, and sensationalized “evidence” over deep, logical analysis.

Is it any wonder? We’re bombarded every minute of every day by countless sources delivering thousands of “news bites” that we must process. These are times of information deluge, deception, and distraction.

That’s why it’s vitally important that we, as Christians, acknowledge that Truth cannot be found in this world or from man’s teachings (Matthew 7:15). We must have faith and trust solely in that Truth which resides *only* in God’s inspired Word.

Biblical discernment. It means to distinguish Truth from error. To recognize “right” from “nearly right.” And to remain diligent through earnest prayers to God and a deep, personal examination of the Holy Scriptures.
