WHAT RIGHTEOUS LIVING LOOKS LIKE *(Rom. 12:9-13)*

“Let love be without hypocrisy” (v.9). The word for love here is “agape.” This is the highest form of love. It’s God’s love. It’s unconditional and unstoppable. Paul says our love must be without hypocrisy. Some pretend to love; they put on a show. Our love must be real, not fake. Real love seeks the best in others.

“Abhor what is evil; cling to what is good” (v. 9). Abhor—Not just simply dislike! It’s hate, loathe, or despise. It’s possible for evil to become so familiar to us that we cease to hate it. Why hate evil? Evil is against God. Evil destroys lives. Evil sends multitudes to hell. So, cling to what is good. How many of you think worship, Bible study, evangelism, prayer, and purity are good? Then cling to what is good.

“Be devoted to one another in brotherly love” (v. 10). Did you know that the word brother is used 230 times from Acts to Revelation? We are brothers and sisters in Christ. Christianity is a family religion. God is Father, and we are brothers and sisters. Paul says act like family and love one another.

“Give preference to one another in honor” (v. 10). This admonition is counter-cultural. Culture cries, “Self!” Our text cries, “Others.” We must rise above our culture and honor others.

“Not lagging behind in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord” (v. 11). Lagging behind means being slothful or lazy. We are to be characterized by diligence, not laziness. How many of us are zealous for God and His kingdom. Do zeal and fervor describe your service?

“Rejoice in hope” (v. 12). Hope is desire plus expectation for good things in the future. Without hope, life would be unbearable. No matter how bad things might be now, “hope” says it will be better tomorrow. Hope is the anchor of the soul. It gives stability and backbone to face life with all of its hardships.

“Persevere in tribulation” (v. 12). Serving the Lord means satanic opposition. When you start serving God, Satan turns on you with all of his fury. We must persevere in times of trial or difficulty.

“Be devoted to prayer” (v. 12). Prayer is the voice of faith. Prayer is powerful. How powerful is prayer, you ask? How powerful is God? There is your answer. No Christian or church will ever accomplish much without prayer. BE DEVOTED TO PRAYER!

“Contributing to the needs of the saints, practicing hospitality (v. 13). The early Christians were good at this (Acts 2:44-45; 4:34-35). It is our responsibility to relieve the poor and needy. It is not the responsibility of the government. Share and be hospitable.
