Pursuing God (Psa. 42:1; 63:1)

“Pursue” means to chase, run after, hunt. It’s not casual. It’s intentional. I love reading the psalms of David. David had a heart after God. You can feel it as you read. Listen to David in **Psalm 42:1-2**: *“As the deer pants for the water brooks, So pants my soul for You, O God. My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When shall I come and appear before God?”* Or how about this, **Psalm 63:1**: *“O God, You [are] my God; Early will I seek You; My soul thirsts for You; My flesh longs for You In a dry and thirsty land Where there is no water.”*

Why pursue God? We pursue what we believe will satisfy us. The world promises satisfaction in success, approval, and comfort. They leave us thirsty (**John 4:13**). Only God can truly satisfy us (**John 4:14**).

How to pursue God. With your whole heart (**Jer. 29:13; Matt. 6:33**). God isn’t hiding. He’s waiting. When you seek after Him with your whole heart, you will find him. *“...The LORD [is] with you while you are with Him. If you seek Him, He will be found by you; but if you forsake Him, He will forsake you”* (2 Chron. 15:2b).

What happens when you pursue God? Jesus says, *“But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.”* Pursuit has a promise. Listen to James: *“Draw near to God and He will draw near to you”* (Jas. 4:8). When you take one step forward, He runs to you (**Lu. 15:20**). The goal of pursuit isn’t more knowledge about God. It’s more of God Himself. You don’t just want blessings from His hand. You want Him.
